PRESIDENTS REPORT 2025 - ALISON CLARK

Thankyou to everyone that has been a part of the 2025 netball Winter season and all of your efforts to support the club. Thankyou to the committee for everything you do behind the scenes. Without you the club couldn't successfully operate. Thankyou to all of our umpires for officiating our games and trying your hardest for a fair and friendly game environment. Thankyou to all of the parents and supporters for getting your child to training and games and being there to support them. A big thank you to our coaches and managers for volunteering your time.

This year has been a tumultuous one with many conflicts and issues due to the increased size of the club and the inability to accommodate everyone's needs and expectations. We started grading and were unprepared for the sheer increase in numbers of participants. We quickly had to adapt so that the second grading session could run smoothly and every player had a chance out on court. The club engages experienced and independent graders so that we can form unbiased teams with players of equal ability. There will always be teams where there are significant differences between the best player and those that are still developing. Beaumaris is a development club and as such does not turn away players due to lack of ability.

However, we have reached and exceeded our limit with 26 teams this year, one of which ended up disbanding before the competition started. We initially struggled with a coach for the team but that was resolved. By the time we had sorted the coach out a few of the players and parents had lost faith and withdrawn to play with other clubs. We were able to accommodate the few remaining players or help them find another club. With that number of teams our training courts are at capacity and our administration is unable to cope. For 2026 our registration cutoffs will be stricter and late registrations will be on a case by case basis. I urge members to get their registrations in on time.

We had a few successes this year with players participating at Association level with JETS and teams participating in additional carnivals throughout the year. Our new uniform was well received and the committee was pleased to be able to offer every registration a new uniform. Next year the uniforms will need to be purchased and we have one more year where the old uniform can still be worn during competitions. We collected any old uniforms and donated them to Siones Foundation, a charity supporting the Tonga community.

This is my last year as President and I am handing over the reins to the next generation of club committee. I hope that the future for Beaumaris Netball club remains strong.

DEVELOPMENT REPORT 2025 - LAUREN KERSHAW

As the 2025 winter season finishes, it's a moment to think back on what has been both a challenging and rewarding year for our club.

I would like to start by saying a big thank you to the Beaumaris committee for all their hard work and to all our coaches for the hours and hours of time volunteered to the club. Unless you have been on a club committee, it is hard to comprehend the amount of behind the scenes work that goes on.

This year, we faced a particularly complex grading process as we worked to place players into the most appropriate teams based on their skills, experience, and potential. With a large pool of talented players and increased demand for teams, space to train and coaches, the grading process became more intricate than ever. I would like to thank our external and internal graders for your help. This year we had a total of 25 teams at the commencement of the season. This put us up 3 teams this year, this being one of the biggest years this club has had.

This year we had 15 players trial for the JETs program, with 8 players being successful into the program. This was a testament to the hard work these players put in, and we're thrilled to see them take their netball journey to the next level.

For those not selected and for those who didn't trial, I would encourage you to continue to trial and work hard as it is a great opportunity to develop your skills and play at a higher level and get the experience of working with different coaches and playing with different teammates.

This year we also had specialist state league players run coaching clinics to help develop our player and coaching skills. These clinics, led by expert coaches in the specific areas of shooting, defence, and mid-court play, gave players the opportunity to receive specialised coaching and zone in on their individual skills. The response to these clinics was overwhelmingly positive, and we're planning to expand on this in the future to provide even more focused development opportunities.

Thank you to every player, coach, volunteer, and supporter for your dedication and hard work this season. It is an absolute privilege to be part of such a dynamic and passionate club, and I look forward to seeing all the exciting things we will achieve together next season.

Diane – You are what we should all aspire to be. Still playing and enjoying netball and kicking butt every game. I wish I was as fit as you are, thanks for joining the team this year.


Lauren – Always a strong leader and great to see you come out in the GD position with your improved fitness. You've done a great job this year as captain and I love everything you do for the team and the club.
